NOTIFICATION

The 28th January, 2008

No. HL B.514/2006/29: The Governor of Assam is hereby pleased to make the following rules, further to amend the Assam Medical Colleges (Regulation of Admission of Post-Graduate Courses) Rules, 2006, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules, namely :-

Short title, Commencement and application

1.

(1) These rules may be called the Assam Medical Colleges (Regulation of Admission to Post-Graduate Courses) (Amendment) Rules, 2008.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

(3) They shall apply to the pool seats, to be rotated between different candidates in every session by the Selection Board available in all the three Medical Colleges of Assam in all disciplines for the Post-Graduate Degree and Diploma Courses as stated in the Principal Rules.

Insertion of a new Sub-rule in rule 4

2.

In the Principal Rules, in rule 4, after sub-rule (6), the following new sub-rule (7) shall be inserted, namely :-

"(7) 3% of the seats in Post-Graduate Courses shall be reserved for the candidates with Physical Disability in the following manner :-

(i) The candidates applying for seats under 3% Physical Disability (Physically Handicapped) Quota shall have to produce identity certificate from the State Level Medical Board/ District Level Medical Board as constituted in pursuance of Social Welfare Department's Notification No. SWD.181/96/76 dt. 21-06-1990 alongwith a certificate regarding percentage (%) of disability issued from the Head of the Department of Orthopaedics of any of the Medical

Colleges of Assam. The Medical Board will have to follow the working principles and instructions for issuance of identity certificate to physically disabled persons as issued by Social Welfare Department O.M. No. SWD.181/96/55, dtd. 31-03-1999. The valid disability certificate of the candidates are to be obtained from the Medical Board as stated above as well as from Head of Orthopaedic Department of any Medical College of Assam having been issued within 3 months prior to presenting his/her application for seeking admission.

(ii) The aforesaid 3% reservation for Physically Handicapped Category in Post-Graduate Courses is not a separate reservation over and above other reservation. If the disabled candidate belongs to reserved categories such as SC/ST/ OBC/MOBC or General and other category he/she shall be adjusted against the pool seats earmarked for the respective session in the category to which he/she belongs to. Only persons with locomotor disability of lower limbs and having between 50% to 70% of the disability shall be eligible for this quota.

(iii) The Government in the Health Department shall constitute a Medical Board consisting of not less than three Experts in Orthopaedics Surgery nominated from Medical Colleges of Assam for assessment of disability of the students seeking admission at the time of counselling. If there is any doubt in certificate indicating the degree of disability issued by the Medical Board constituted by Social Welfare Department, opinion of the aforesaid Medical Board constituted by the Government shall be final for selection of the candidate.

(iv) In case the number of Physically Handicapped candidates are more than the allotted number of pool seats for a particular category, then the decision of the Selection Board taken on the basis of percentage or degree of disability, at the time of counselling, shall be final and binding for allotment of seat to the excess number of candidates."

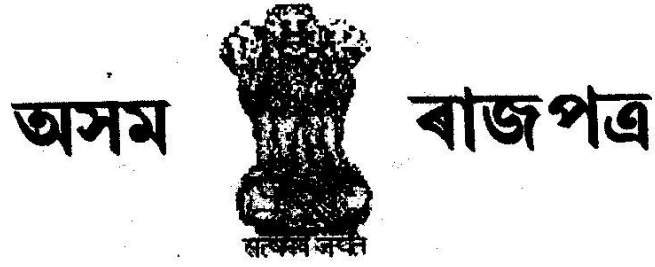

In this Principal Rules, in rule 5, in clause (D), in sub-clause (vi), for the existing last sentence, "This shall also be applicable for candidates under State Health Service quota 50% marks for General Candidates and 40% marks for reserved categories", the following sentence shall be substituted, namely: -

"To be eligible for admission of candidates under State Health Service quota both General and Reserved Category shall have to secure minimum 40% marks in the Entrance Examination conducted for this purposes".

No.HLB.400/2009/23: The Governor of Assam is hereby pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Assam Medical Colleges (Regulation of Admission to Post-Graduate Courses) Rules, 2006 herein after referred to as the principal Rules, namely:-

Short title,
Commencement
and application

- (1) These rules may be called the Assam Medical Colleges (Regulation of Admission to Post-Graduate Courses) (Amendment) Rules, 2010.
- (2) They shall be applicable to regulate the admission to Post-Graduate Degree/Diploma Courses in the Medical Colleges of Assam and shall cover the academic session from 2010.
- (3) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

Amendment of rule 2

2.

In the principal Rules, in rule 2, after clause (ix), the following new clauses shall be inserted, namely:-

"(x) "All India Quota" means the seats reserved for the students selected by the Central Government through All India Entrance Examination,

(xi) "Remote and Difficult Area" means an area which is situated in the two hill Districts of Assam i.e. North Cachar Hills and Karbi Anglong District as well as remote areas namely, Dhemaji District, Sadia Sub-division, Majuli Sub-division Dhakuakhana Sub-division and South Salmara Sub-division other than the head quarters of the said Districts/ Sub-divisions."

Amendment of rule 4

3.

In the Principal Rules, in rule 4, -

(i) in sub-rule (3), -

(a) for clause (i), the following shall be substituted namely:-

"(i) 20 seats shall be reserved for each session namely session 2010 and session 2011 only in degree courses for the teachers belonging to the three Medical Colleges of Assam who have joined service after due selection through the Commission or whose services were regularized by the Commission. They shall have to appear before the Selection Board constituted under clause (ii) of this sub-rule:

Provided that if any of the Teacher's Quota seats are not filled up due to non-availability of an eligible candidate in a particular year, then the vacant seat shall be filled up by candidates from the merit list of the respective year in order of merit."

(b) for clause (vi), the following shall be substituted, namely :-

"(vi) Upto a maximum of 4(four) seats in a subject shall be allowed in each session for teacher quota."

(ii) in sub-rule (4), for clause (i), the following shall be substituted, namely :-

"(i) 23(twenty three) seats – 6 in P.G. Degree and 17 in P.G. Diploma Courses shall be reserved for the doctors appointed under the State Health Services on regular basis on recommendation of the Commission and who have completed 5 years or more service in rural areas. However, for counting the experience of 5 years of service in rural areas period working under regulation 3(f) of the Assam Public Service Commission (Limitation and Functions) Regulation, 1951 or service under any Society/ Agency created by the Government for implementation of National Programme of disease control or National Rural Health Mission shall also be counted. Five years service in rural areas should be a continuous service in such areas and the applicant must complete the required period of service in rural areas at the time of submission of the application for Entrance Examination. The subject wise reservation of seats have been shown in Appendix-I."

(iii) for sub-rule (6), the following shall be substituted, namely :-

"(6) Pool: (i) The following number of seats shall be pool seats to be rotated between different candidates in every session by the Selection Board Serially (details in Appendix-I) and shall be filled up according to merit :-

Amendment of rule 5

4.

In the principal Rules, in rule 5, -

(i) in clause (A), in sub-clause (ii), after serial No. 6, the following new serial No.7 shall be inserted, namely :-

"7. Certificate relating to service in rural area (As in Appendix-III)"

(ii) in clause (D), after sub-clause (xv), the following new sub-clause (xvi) shall be inserted, namely :-

"(xvi) In determining the merit in the Entrance Examination for Post Graduate admission, additional mark shall be given at the rate of 10% of the marks obtained in the Entrance Examination, against completion of each year of service in "remote and difficult areas" subject to maximum of 30% of the total marks obtained, provided the candidate produces

certificate/ certificates to that effect issued by the Director, Health Services/ Director, Health Services (FW)/ Joint Director, Health Services of the concerned area, in the format as prescribed at Appendix-IV:

Provided that such marks obtained after inclusion of additional marks shall not exceed the total marks of the Entrance Examination:

Provided, however, that the period of service in remote and difficult areas shall be counted with effect from 01-01-2010 onwards only and service offered prior to this date shall not be counted for awarding this additional marks:

Provided also that Doctors serving in rural areas in establishment other than establishment of the Government of Assam or Society/Agency created for implementation of National Programmes of disease control or National Rural Health Mission shall not be eligible to be awarded additional marks as mentioned above."

Insertion in rule 6

5. In the principal Rules, in rule 6, after clause (v), the following new clauses (vi) and (vii) shall be inserted, namely :-
 "(vi) A candidate prior to his appearance in the P.G. Entrance Examination shall have to serve under the Government of Assam for the period as stipulated in the Bond signed by the candidate after being selected for the MBBS Course as per The Medical Colleges of Assam and Regional Dental College (Regulation of Admission of Under Graduate Students) Rules 2007 and in breach thereof shall pay compensation as mentioned in the said Bond to the Government before he/she applies for the Post Graduate Entrance Examination against the State Quota Seats:

Provided that he/she shall also be eligible to apply in lieu of above mentioned provision if the conditions of the Office Memorandum vide No.HLB/400/2009/06, dated 28-08-2009 relating to the period of service in rural areas as contained therein are fulfilled by a candidate :

Provided however, that a candidate who does not want to serve under the Government for a period of 5 years as stipulated in the Bond duly signed and delivered by him/her after being selected for the MBBS Course, or the required period of service in rural areas as laid down in the OM. No. HLB./400/2009/06, dated the 28-08-2009 may pay the compensation as stipulated in the Bond, in lieu of such service under the Government, and on such payment he/she shall be eligible to become a candidate for admission to the Post Graduate Courses.

The amount of compensation is to be paid in favour of "Director of Medical Education, Assam" by a Bank Draft payable at Guwahati at the time of submission of the application for admission to the Post Graduate Courses.

(vii) The doctors who have been serving/ has served in rural areas shall have to produce certificate/ certificates to the effect that he/she has been working/ has worked in rural areas under the Government of Assam or under Society/ Agency created by the Government for implementation of National

Programmes of disease control or under National Rural Health Mission for period as stipulated under these rules and/or the Office Memorandum vide No. HLB/400/2009/06, dated 28-08-2009. Certificate/ Certificates shall have to be produced along with the application as per format at Appendix-III."

Insertion in rule 7

6. In the principal Rules, in rule 7, in sub-rule (4), after clause (f), a new clause (g) shall be inserted namely :-

"(g) Certificate relating to service in rural areas (as in Appendix-III)"

Insertion in rule 12

7. In the principal Rules, in rule 12, after the existing provision, the following shall be inserted, namely :-

"The student who takes admission in Post-Graduate Courses under All India Quota in the Medical Colleges of Assam and desires to receive stipend awarded by the Government of Assam shall have to execute a Bond as executed by the State Quota candidates, binding himself/ herself to serve under the Government of Assam for a period of 10(ten) years on completion of the Post Graduate Course and in breach thereof to pay a sum of maximum of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees ten lakhs) only to the Government as compensation and deliver the same to the Government. However, if any student from All India Quota does not want to receive the stipend, he/she shall be exempted from the purview of this Bond."

Insertion in rule 14

8. In the principal Rules, in rule 14, after sub-rule (iv) the following sub-rule (v) shall be inserted, namely :-

"(v) The candidate admitted in the Post-Graduate Courses through All India Quota will be given stipend as fixed by Government from time to time, provided they execute a Bond to serve under the Government of Assam as provided in rule 12."

Substitution of Appendix-I

9. In the principal Rules, for the existing Appendix-I, the following shall be substituted, namely :-

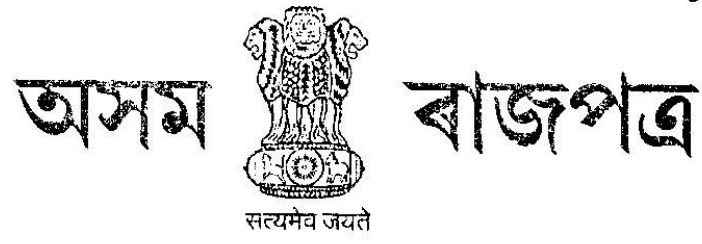

No. HLB.400/09/58.- The Governor of Assam is hereby pleased to make the following rules, further to amend the Assam Medical Colleges (Regulation of Admission of Post Graduate Course) Rules, 2006, hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules, namely :-

Short title, Commencement and application	1	<p>(1) These rules may be called the Assam Medical Colleges (Regulation of Admission to Post Graduate Courses) (Amendment) Rules, 2012.</p> <p>(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.</p> <p>(3) They shall be applicable to regulate the admission of students into the Post Graduate Degree/Diploma Courses in the Medical Colleges of Assam and shall cover the academic session from 2012.</p>
Amendment of Rule 4	2	<p>In the principal rules, in rule 4,-</p> <p>(i) in sub-rule (3),-</p> <p>(a) for clauses (i), (ii) and (iv), the following shall be substituted, namely:-</p> <p>“(i) Five seats in Degree Courses with a maximum of Two seats in a subject shall be reserved for the teachers belonging to the Medical Colleges of Assam in each session. The teachers shall be eligible for making application for allotment of teachers quota seats in the subjects where they are already working. If any of the Teacher’s quota seat is not filled up due to non-availability of an eligible candidate in a particular year, then the vacant seat shall be filled up by candidates from the merit list of Post Graduate Entrance Examination of the respective year in order of merit.</p> <p>(ii) For the purpose of allotment of the teachers quota seats the Joint Director of Medical Education, Assam cum Member Secretary of Selection Board shall invite applications from the teachers belonging to the Medical Colleges of Assam through their respective Principals before starting the counseling for the session. The selection of the candidates from the applications for the seats reserved under this Quota shall be made by a Selection Board consisting of the Principals of the Medical Colleges of Assam as Members and Director of Medical Education, Assam as the Chairman and the Joint Director of Medical Education, Assam as Member Secretary, on the basis of seniority cum merit. The interse seniority of the candidates shall be determined as per APSC nomination and Government rule in this regard. APPENDIX -II
(DEED OF AGREEMENT)

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on this day of 20.... between the State of Assam, Health and Family Welfare Department to be represented by Sri S/O aged about Years, presently holding the post of in the Health and Family Welfare Department, hereinafter to be referred as the **First Party**.

-And-

Dr. S/O aged about Years, R/O Dist., Assam hereinafter referred as **Second Party**.

WHEREAS the **Second Party** has obtained MBBS Degree from Medical College and Hospital and now intending to take admission in Post Graduate Course in the Medical Colleges of Assam, namely at

AND WHEREAS the **Second Party** shall bear only the admission fees, hostel fees, and other charges for the course and the **First Party** shall give the monthly stipend to the **Second Party** during the period of the course.

AND WHEREAS the State of Assam shall incur huge revenue from State Exchequer for the purpose of imparting education to the **Second Party** in pursuing the P.G. Course in a State Medical College in Assam.

AND WHEREAS in the interest of public service, the **First Party** has decided to give admission to the **Second Party** in the Post Graduate Courses at Medical College Hospital in the State of Assam and shall bear the expenses of his/her education, other than the admission fees, hostel fees and other charges, in pursuing the said course.

NOW, THERE OF THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSES THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. That after completion of his/her Post Graduate Course, the **Second Party** shall serve the State Government for a minimum period of 10(ten) years upon offer of appointment in any State Government Service in the Health and Allied sector including agencies/ institutions under NRHM and/or any other State/Central Government sponsored Scheme/s or in any part of the State.
2. That the **First Party** shall have the authority to utilize the service of the student i.e., the **Second Party** in any Hospital/ Medical Institution within the State of Assam where is necessity of a specialist in the interest of public service.
3. That the **Second Party** shall be governed by the Assam Medical Colleges (Regulation of Admission to Post Graduate Courses) Rules, 2006 amended upto 2012.
4. That in case of any breach of the terms and conditions as stated hereinabove, the **Second Party** shall be liable to pay an amount of Rs.20 lakhs (Rupees twenty lakhs) only [Rs.25 lakhs (Rupees twenty five lakhs) only for those admitted under Rule 4(4)(vi)] as compensation to the **First Party**, i.e., the Government of Assam, Health and Family Welfare Department on account of the expenses borne for the Second Party in pursuing the P.G. Course.
5. That, in case of failure to pay the compensation as mentioned above, the **First Party** shall be at liberty to file a Money Suit and/or to take any other appropriate legal action against the **Second Party** in the competent court to recover the same at the risk and cost of the **Second Party**.
