Applications are invited from the candidates for GNM Entrance Examination (GNMEE) for selection of candidates for admission into GNM Course under the **Directorate of Health Services, Assam** in both Govt. and Private Institutes for the session 2025-26. Online Application Form shall be available at Srimanta Sankaradeva University of Health Sciences website: www.ssuhs.in from **13-05-2025 to 13-06-2025**. The Online Application Form must be filled up after carefully going through the instructions given along with the form in the website.

The Entrance Test is going to be held on **13-07-2025 (Sunday)** at Guwahati, Dibrugarh, Silchar, Jorhat, Barpeta, Tezpur, Diphu, Lakhimpur, Nagaon, Nalbari, Dhubri and Kokrajhar.

Details including Eligibility Criteria and Requirements of the GNM Entrance Examination for selection of Candidates for Admission into GNM Course under the Directorate of Health Services, Assam in both Govt. and Private Institutes for the Session 2025-2026

1. The Entrance Examination shall be held on **13-07-2025 (Sunday)** from 11.00 AM to 1.00 PM at Guwahati, Dibrugarh, Silchar, Jorhat, Barpeta, Tezpur, Diphu, Lakhimpur, Nagaon, Nalbari, Dhubri & Kokrajhar for selection of candidates for admission into GNM Course in both Govt. and Private GNM Training Schools under the Directorate of Health Services, Assam.
2. There will be 1 (one) paper consisting of (a) English (b) Mathematics (c) General Science. The questions of these subjects shall be of 10th standard.
3. The Examination shall be for 100 marks. (100 Questions x 1 Mark each).
English – 50 marks, Mathematics – 25 marks and General Science – 25 marks.
4. There shall be no negative marking for wrong answers. Unanswered questions shall be awarded zero marks.
5. The questions will be in both English & Assamese language. However, the candidates will be required to fill in the OMR Sheet of the Entrance Examination in English only.

Eligibility criteria for admission into GNM Course in the GNM Training Schools under the Govt. of Assam:

1. Applicant must be a citizen of India.
2. Permanent Resident Certificate is mandatory for admission in the Govt. Institutes of Assam.
3. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December, 2025. The upper age limit is 35 years. For RANM/RLHV, there is no age bar.
4. The minimum educational qualification for selection of the GNM candidates is
 - a. 10+2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English individually from any recognized board. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by

Central Government. However Science is preferable. Three (core elective) subject marks may be taken for calculating the percentage of marks excluding the marks in English. Also, it has to be ensured the candidate has pass marks in English.

- b. 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in vocational ANM course from the schools recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
 - c. 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in Vocational Stream-Health care Science from a recognized CBSE board/State/Centre.
 - d. Registered ANM with pass marks.
- 5. Student shall be medically fit.
 - 6. Student shall be admitted once in a year.
 - 7. The reservation of seats for GNM Training course in Govt. Institutes shall be as per Assam Govt. norms.

However, the distribution and reservation of seats including admission shall be notified by Directorate of Health Services, Assam in due course of time.

Important note:

- 1. The merit list shall be prepared based on the total marks obtained by each candidate in the Entrance Examination. If two or more candidates secure the same mark in the Entrance Examination, the inter-se merit of such candidates shall be determined in order of preference as follows:
 - a. Candidates securing more marks in English in the Entrance Examination.
 - b. Candidates securing more marks in General Science in the Entrance Examination.
 - c. If the marks further tally, then marks in English, then General Science, then Mathematics of qualifying examination shall be considered at the time of counselling.
- 2. The minimum qualifying criteria/ cut off score in the Entrance Examination of **GNM Course** will be as follows:
 - I. For Govt. Institutions:
 - a. General (UR/EWS) – 30th Percentile
 - b. SC/ST/OBC (NCL)/ Divyang – 20th Percentile
 - II. For Private Institutions (For 50% Management Quota Seats):
 - i. General (UR/EWS) – 20th Percentile
 - ii. SC/ST/OBC (NCL) – 18th Percentile
 - iii. Divyang – 15th Percentile



III. For Private Institutions (Rest 50% seats):

- i. General (UR/EWS) – 18th Percentile
- ii. SC/ST/OBC (NCL) – 15th Percentile
- iii. Divyang – 15th Percentile

3. Any information given by the applicant if found to be false, incomplete or any ineligibility criteria detected at any stage later on shall mark her disqualified from the Entrance Examination with all its associated consequences.
4. As the form is to be submitted online, the candidates are not required to send any document to the University. All necessary verification/scrutiny of the related documents of the candidates regarding eligibility, reservation etc. will be done at the time of counseling.
5. The candidates are to keep note of their **Application Form Number and Password**.
6. They are to download the Admit Card from the University website: www.ssuhs.in from **01-07-2025** onwards by entering their Application Form Number and Password.
7. **In case the Application Form Number and Password are misplaced/lost/forgotten by the applicant, she will not be able to download her Admit Card. Hence, the applicants are directed to be very serious in keeping note of the Application Form No. and Password.
